In their decision, the Supreme Court did indeed find the requirement of the prayer to be unconstitutional. The Supreme Court had, in essence, re-drawn constitutional lines by ruling that public schools, as part of the "state," were no longer a place for the practice of religion.

The Importance of the Business Judgment Rule

The decision in Fraser rested on the "vulgar," "lewd," and "plainly offensive" character of a speech delivered at an official school assembly rather than on [484 U.S. 260, 272] any propensity of the speech to "materially disrupt classwork or involv[e] substantial disorder or invasion of the rights of others." 393 U.S., at 513 .

The business judgment rule (Rule), the most prominent and important standard of judicial review under corporate law, protects a decision of a corporate board of directors (Board) from a fairness review ("entire fairness" under Delaware law) unless a well pleaded complaint provides sufficient evidence that the Board has breached its fiduciary duties or that the [...]
